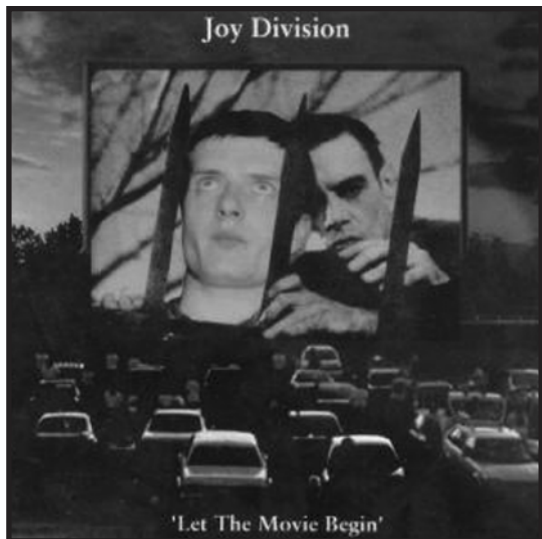

OVERVIEW

Put together by a couple of Belgian Joy Division experts to celebrate the 25th anniversary of the sadly missed **Ian Curtis** and the year that filming of the Ian Curtis Movie is to begin - if not filming of two different movies!

This CD contains interviews of all the members of Joy Division interspersed with superb live performances from various venues through the career of the band including rarities from Dutch and Belgian concert performances and a couple of rare alternative studio outtakes.

The featured interviews are extremely - some have never seen the light of day before. There is also a spoken word contribution Joy Division producer **Martin Hannett** as well as a rare Martin Hannett interview.

The 8-page foldout full colour cd booklet contains lots of Joy Division images and a detailed biographical article on the band.

ARTIST BIO

Joy Division was born in 1976 in Greater Manchester, UK in the wake of the **Sex Pistols** entrance onto the UK underground. Originally playing gigs under the name Warsaw, the band changed their name to Joy Division to avoid being confused with London punk band Warsaw Pakt. The name was in reference to groups of Jewish women used as sex slaves in Nazi concentration camps depicted in **Ka-Tzetnik 135633's** 1955 novel **The House of Dolls**. Joy Division became the first band in the post-punk movement by later emphasizing not anger and energy but mood and expression, pointing ahead to the rise of melancholy in alternative music in the '80s. Though the group's raw initial sides fit the bill for any punk band, Joy Division later incorporated synthesizers (taboo in the low-tech world of '70s punk) and more haunting melodies, emphasized by the isolated, tortured lyrics of its lead vocalist, Ian Curtis. While the British punk movement shocked the world during the late '70s, Joy Division's quiet storm of musical restraint and emotive power proved to be just as important to independent music in the 1980s. Sadly as the band stood on the brink of commercial success it all quickly came to an end. Curtis was found dead in his home, the victim of a self-inflicted hanging. Joy Division is still one of the most influential rock bands of the 20th century. The band, and especially Ian Curtis, has been an inspiration for a number of musicians and groups, including **Smashing Pumpkins**, Trent Reznor (**Nine Inch Nails** covered "Dead Souls" for the soundtrack of the movie *The Crow*), Robert Smith of **The Cure**, and Red Hot Chili Peppers guitarist **John Frusciante**.
