ARTIST BIO

Breadfoot is Stephan Meyers, a seminal force in NYC's burgeoning anti-folk scene. Anna Phoebe is a renowned violinist who has worked with huge names such as **Leann Rimes**, **George Michaels**, and is a full-time member and String Master of the tremendously popular **Trans-Siberian Orchestra**. Producer Leo Abrahams has worked with **Brian Eno**, **Starsailor**, **David Holmes**, and contributed to the **Ocean's Twelve** score.

DESCRIPTION

Recorded in London over the course of just two days of stunning collaboration, *Tea with Leo* makes for a delightfully satisfying musical blend. Steeped in the rich old-timey country blues tradition that is Breadfoot and generously laced with the vibrant and evocative violin of Anna Phoebe, *Tea with Leo* is indeed a fine example of what can happen when two truly gifted musicians, in the words of **Babysue**, "get together to play out of the pure love of playing."

The result is an album that is at turns breezy and melancholy; celebrating the folk roots of banjo, guitar and violin virtuosity. With a yearning only a country boy living in the city can convey and the sophistication of a classical violinist who has played for the royalty of several nations, it's clear why *Tea with Leo* has been lauded by critics in the U.S. and the U.K., despite only having been available on the artists' websites until now.

Though a scant eight tracks clocking in at just under 25 minutes (including one bonus track), the album conveys a rich breadth of emotion and accomplished musicianship that most artists are lucky to capture over the course of a career.
